MIXED AMATEUR: Confined to amateurs partnering other than their regular amateur partner; an advanced amateur competitor/ teacher partnering another amateur dancer who is his or her student dancer in "Mixed Amateur" competition categories. Mixed Amateur events are offered at all ages and all levels. A Mixed Couple is defined as a couple whereby the partners are either (1) different age levels and/or (2) different levels. Only the designated partner is judged in

Amateur Mixed Partnerships.

The Non-Judged Amateur cannot be a Professional Dancer. NDCA defines a Professional Dancer as anyone who is any or all of the following (anyone studying for or taking a theory exam will not be deemed a professional unless they declare themselves such as defined below): **a.** Registered as a Professional with the NDCA. **b.** One who partners a Pro/Am Student Dancer or Registered Amateur in Pro/AmCompetition. **c.** Any person who declares himself or herself a Professional by word or deed (Examples: serving as a hired Partner, or participating in Professional Competitions or Team Matches).
